SYDNEY ROYAL AGILITY WRAP UP!!!!

Good Morning from Victoria.

As we ramp up preparations for the National Agility Championships in Victoria, with many club members planning road trips with their best friends, one of the lead up Agility Events was the prestigious Sydney Royal. With that having been completed this week, the Agility was held on the last day of the Show and all Manly Club members who entered did exceptionally well.

With the Sydney Royal being held over 12 days this year, this meant that the Agility was conducted over just one day, but this did not discourage the crowds. The event was held in the Howie Dog Pavilion, in the undercover arena and with a large grandstand for the public to sit, watch and cheer on each and every dog that ran. It is also located directly beside "sideshow alley" with the screams and bangs of the rides and games. Yes this can be quite daunting for some puppies, but each and every dog and handler combination work together to overcome these challenges.

The competitions held this year were Novice, Excellent, Masters and Open Jumping and then Novice, Excellent and Masters Agility. We started at 8am and were finished by 4.30pm. This makes for a very long day for some.

Our judges this year were Sallie Remon (jumping) from New Zealand (this was her first agility judging appointment in Australia) and Kendal Olsen (agility) from Tasmania and they put some fantastic courses on the ground for us to run.

Liver Fudge

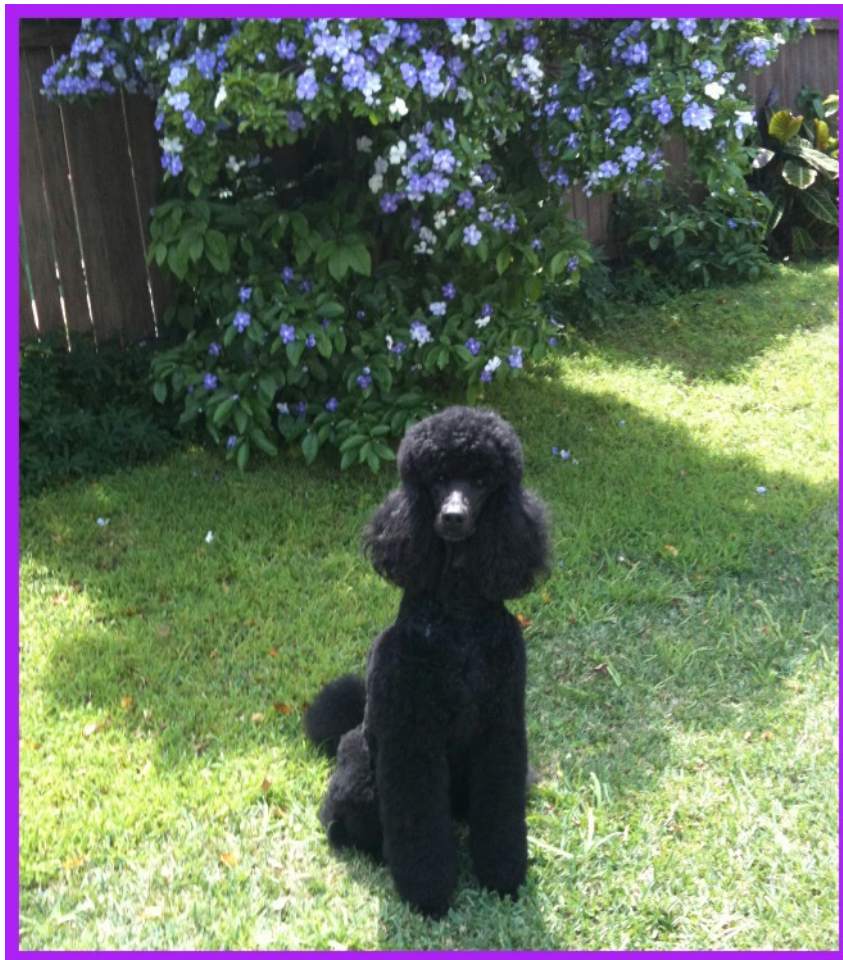
- 1 x Large Lambs Liver
- 2 x Eggs
- 1 x Cup of Flour

Cut liver into chunks and blend, add eggs and flour and blend to a smooth texture. Pour mixture into a lined baking tray and bake at 180° for 15 - 20 minutes.

When cool cut into small squares using a pizza wheel, then divide into portions and freeze until needed.

Brunfelsia, "Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow" is extremely toxic, especially the berries. This plant can kill, so don't take chances, if you have one in your garden rip it out or fence it off.

TAMMY RETIRES FROM AGILITY AT AGE 18!



Tammy my beautiful Maltese rescue dog (pictured left) came to live with me aged 4. I already had my first dog Trudy, an 8 year old Maltese x Bichon, competing in agility with Manly Dog Club so Tammy joined in as well. She knew how to jump onto laps and furniture but not over obstacles and land on the ground. She learnt quickly following Trudy but was never quite good enough to trial. However she did win some ribbons on our club course days despite cruciate ligament surgery age 5 and 7.

As many of our agility dogs were ageing and no longer able to jump their regulation heights, we commenced a seniors novice level competition for dogs over 8 who are no longer trialling. They are allowed to jump lower heights, miss unsuitable obstacles and not be disqualified!

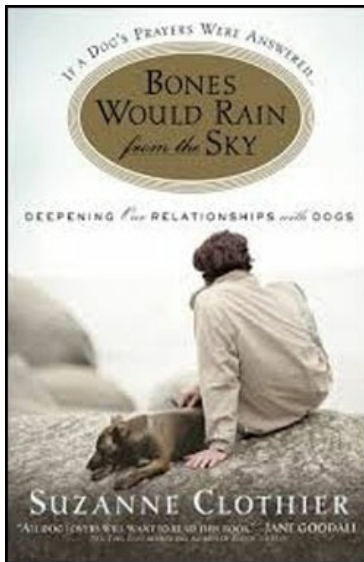
Tammy developed some arthritis, then 4 years ago she had a bad health run. She suffered pancreatitis, was diagnosed with Cushing's Syndrome and spent a week at the vets with tick poisoning.

Despite all this she was happy in herself and continued to compete on club course days, now trotting around with the jumps at ground level.

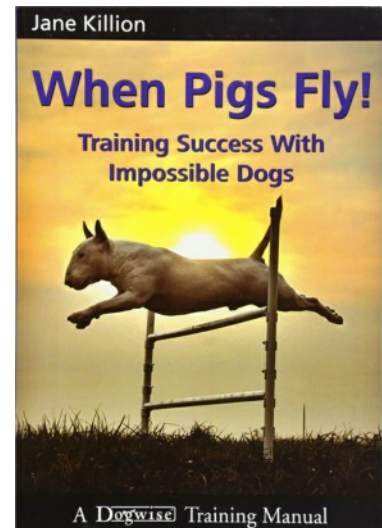
Trudy died at 16yr 9mo and I adopted another rescue dog Tasha, a Maltese x terrier I call my Maltese terror! (now 9 years old) She and Tammy competed in the Seniors annual point score in 2017. Tasha came 2nd and Tammy 3rd! - due to regular attendance rather than agility skills.

Before Christmas Tammy was diagnosed with heart failure so this year at age 18 she has finally retired, although you will see us all at Agility on Saturdays.

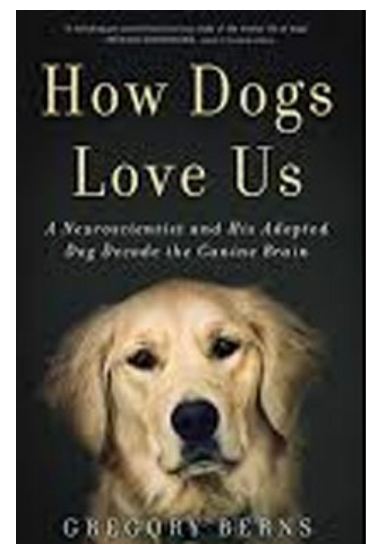

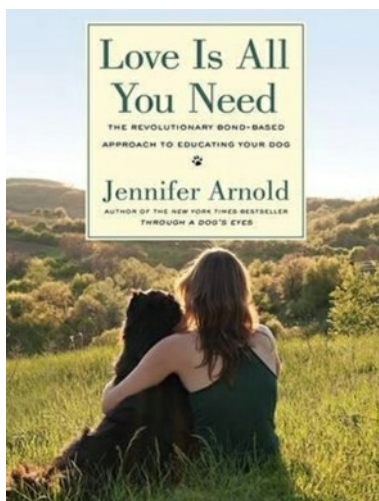
